# **Business Continuity**

(Compliance / preparedness monitored by MRF Secretariat

- Use CRR to prioritise workload
- Test, monitor and assess public awareness of risk
- Scope, plan and deliver Merseyside-wide multiagency risk awareness/preparedness campaigns and events
- Develop and maintain Merseyside Prepared website; monitor website activity ("hits"), act as governance group for website content
- Recommend media/warning & informing training and exercising opportunities
- Merseyside Media Protocol in an Emergency
- MRF Warning & Informing Plan
